



Directions for Regatta Registrants

1. Please register prior to the date of the event if possible.
2. The classes of entrants are delineated on the registration form. Please adhere to boat length constraints.
3. All boats should be brought to the staging area (the spillway bridge) by noon on race day.
4. Registrants will be allowed to drive boats to the spillway area to drop off their boats and return after the race. The vehicles of registrants will be parked in a designated area of the parking lot. Volunteers will be available to help with unloading and loading.
5. Events will proceed one after the other without adherence to a predetermined schedule.
6. Registrants should be attentive to the order of the heats, and be with their boats for placement of the boats prior to the heat and removal of boats after each heat.
7. Up to five boats will participate in each heat. The boats will line up at the spillway, and when the air horn is sounded race upstream toward Reedy Creek. The finish line will be a site line across the lake, and the line-judge (Roger Clark) will declare the winner. The ruling of the judge is final.
8. After the heat, please proceed quickly back to the spill-way and assist with removal of your boat to make room for the next heat.
9. All registrants will receive t-shirts, and race winners will receive an award.
10. Please make the safety of you and the other competitors and care of the boats your top priority.
